#### MODERATOR'S MESSAGE



"April Showers Bring May Flowers!" Spring has arrived here in Port Orange and with it comes new growth. I am not just referring to trees, flowers and lawns but to our church and our church family. Over the past few years, including the unwanted interruption by Covid-19, our church has been changing. Some will classify this change as a negative (we have been losing members) and others will classify it as a positive (we are still here in spite of losing members). Both are correct. Now, over the next couple months until the end of May we must prepare for the future for after Pastor Glenn retires. The last Sunday in May will be one service followed by a luncheon as we all wish Pastor Glenn and his family a wonderful, happy & healthy

retirement or possible new exciting adventures in their lives. However, before that date comes, we must start now in preparing ourselves as a church for what comes in June when we will not have a full-time pastor. The effort for this planning has already started when the church council voted to seek out a part-time pastor versus trying to find a full-time pastor. In addition, several of you, our church members, have been asked if you would be on the search committee for this effort. Unlike past search committee responsibilities, this committee will be looking at candidates to fill a part-time pastor position with very limited responsibilities and time required. The profile of what we will require of a part-time pastor is being written now and once completed it will be sent to the UCC Florida Conference for distribution throughout UCC churches nationally. In this process we may hear back from retired pastors already here in Florida who are seeking something part-time. Or, we may hear from retiring pastors nationally who want to continue part-time in a warmer climate such as Florida. Either way, we are expecting good responses. Again, this effort will start in April and continue until we reach a decision on a specific individual or possibly individuals, if we are so fortunate as to have a couple respond to our request. In many ways this is an exciting time and in other ways it is a difficult time. Our church has great members, volunteers and a great staff. We are highly blessed in many ways. It will take everyone through this transition to be involved with an understanding that the decisions coming before us will be for the church as a whole, for our church as a family and for continuing into the future our church missions that may be the same or may be new ones as we discover our role as a church body in what looks like a new world emerging before our eyes each day. The message of Jesus has not changed in over 2,000 years. The mission of the church he started has not changed in that time either. We need to continue sharing the lessons he taught and shared with us. As the Spring of 2022 moves forward with new growth, so will we as the Port Orange United Church of Christ move forward with new growth, new energy and a bright for where we are headed next. ## OPERATION AND FINANCE TEAM REPORT



An update on the progress since our last newsletter article. As has been reported in the past two months of operations reports, much of the exterior upgrades and projects have been completed. We all feel the exterior of the church and grounds look much better.

Mix (Thrift Store) Building Doors:

The new aluminum diamond plate covers for all the Mix building doors have been installed by Malibu Construction, protecting the doors from further damage and/or degrading.

#### Parking Lot Lighting:

All paperwork has been signed with FPL, we hope to have the new LED site lighting installed very soon. We are monitoring the installation progress schedule with FPL. It will enhance not only the visual appearance of the Church and the parking areas but the security of all our property

#### Security Camera System:

Five new cameras have been installed around our buildings to enhance security. The system was installed last month, a monitor and loop feed recorder are installed in the church office.

Our Spring into life campaign for 2022 commenced January 1, so far \$ 3,200.00 + has been donated, won't you consider donating so we can cover the remaining costs from the exterior projects?

We are holding off on any major maintenance projects on the interior (painting, etc.) until we receive donations to cover the remaining costs of the exterior projects, we have detailed in the past three months articles.

Our church is looking clean, bright and welcoming on the exterior, our new irrigation system is keeping the sod green and our landscaping is being maintained well. The committee wishes to thank the members as well as non-members who have supported the exterior projects we have completed, you all have made a significant impact on our church. *Art Horton, Chairman*




