Sometimes in life when you read or see something it makes perfect sense until you think about it for a while and then say to yourself "What?...something's not right here". Well I am happy to report that every thing is going right for our church building, grounds and surprisingly for our finances. Things we need such as fixing toilets, doors and normal wear & tear are being handled as they come and things like replacing our sanctuary computer due to it being old and in need of technology advances is being taken care of as I write this update. With COVID-19 and its mutations still haunting us, we are continuing to keep our sanctuary chairs separated and hand sanitizers available. Masks are optional

during services but we still have a supply available at the front door for those who want one. Thank you to all of you who graciously continue to provide financial support to our church. Your donations whether through regular giving, special gifts, Thrift Store purchases or just placing something extra in the offering plate on Sundays all add up. I need to remind everyone that we also have a **GIVING button** on our church website. When you go to www.portorangeucc.org, you will see a big red button on the first page. Clicking on that button allows anyone, anywhere in the world to make a donation of any size to our church. Some of you are already giving remotely. These donations go directly into our church bank account. Thank you! Hurricane & Tropical Storms...just a guick note to remind everyone that the two forces we need to be concerned about are WIND & WATER INTRUSION. Like your homes, our church has a roof, doors and windows. All are vulnerable. Fortunately, our Jim Reed & Mix building roof s were new last year. Our sanctuary roof is near 10-years old and could be a problem in powerful easterly winds. Our doors and windows for the most part are secure and any water intrusion will come from the wind blowing water under or through them. We have a good supply of "Flood Dams" which can be placed on the floor behind every outside opening door in our church. These flood dams absorb large amounts of water and will help reduce damage inside. Each storm requires these flood dams to be placed down and then removed for reuse after the storm passes. Be sure to take care of your own homes when a storm is coming. One last point, our church has an excellent social room, kitchen and sanctuary. All are available for to be rented. The church council must approve each use and rent amount but we have a rent schedule already prepared should a request be made. Pass the word. We are selective but whenever possible we want to say yes, if it makes sense. That is all for now. Please have a safe and healthy summer. Stay Spiritually connected! 
