# MODERATOR'S MESSAGE

As a church, we are very fortunate to have the services of Pastor Pat Holcomb and her husband Alan supporting our church. Beginning with her first Sunday service June 12<sup>th</sup>,  $\overline{a}$  we have had a powerful message from Pastor Pat each Sunday. As most of you know we have extended an invitation to Pastor Pat and Alan to be with us for a longer period of time that may possibly continue into the future

for as long as they want to be with us. Her official position within the UCC definitions will be as a "Bridge Pastor". This designation is between an "Interim Pastor" and a "Called Pastor". Her position will be Part-time regarding her responsibilities but nevertheless we have already seen that Pastor Pat is a "people person" who has an immediate ability for "getting to know you" when she meets people face to face. Alan, her husband, has the same warm ability to meet people and immediately enjoin in conversations that are warm and open. For those familiar with "Pastor Search Committees" and all the time and dedicated work required to find either an Interim (Temporary) or Called (Permanent) Pastor, the church council has made a decision not to go forward with a search committee effort at this time. We are praying that things will work out that Pastor Pat and Alan will be able to be with us for as long as they like.

Behind the scenes everyone is working hard to make Pastor Pat's and Alan's relocation to our area possible. The one-way two-hour drive from Ocala each Sunday is not a long-term situation. Efforts have already started for finding an affordable property for them to purchase along with selling their existing home near Ocala. These two events alone are challenging as everyone knows who has ever sold and purchased a property involving a move of packing and unpacking. The present real estate market is a tough one for both a lack of properties and the rapid increase in selling prices over the past 2-3 years. All alternatives are being investigated to include renting or leasing until a property becomes available that matches their needs. The search for a property does not need to be just Port Orange but can include the surrounding area within 30minutes of the church. I ask everyone to be alert and if you hear of a property becoming available, please let me know so that I can help research it for Pastor Pat & Alan. The goal is to be in the price range of 250,000 to 300,000 +/and that the home be a single family with at least two bedrooms and two baths (ideally three bedrooms).

# OPERATION'S & FINANCE TEAM



Welcome to August:

My August Operations Committee report is commencing with a few words about our future: We have been blessed by God almighty for sending us Reverend Pat and her husband Alan. In four weeks, they have invigorated our church! Her sermons are from the heart, she speaks to each and every one of us. She and Alan greet our members and guests as they arrive, spend time visiting with them, conduct services, meet the folks after

service and spends time with everyone at coffee hour. They have, in 4 short weeks become involved with our church. You church council is working with them to have them continue for years to come. They are both a bright star for our church. If you have not had the pleasure of meeting Pastor Pat and Alan, I strongly recommend you attend a service sooner than later. Our service is 9:30 every Sunday.

Operations Report: We are working on final planning for the new HVAC systems in the Church proper. The concrete pad for the old chiller will be extended to make room for the new HVAC units. A new fence will be installed around the area once the units are installed. A new electrical panel has been installed to accommodate the new units. Once installed we should see a significant drop in utility costs as the old chiller units was very inefficient.

Our new irrigation pump and system is working extremely well, the grounds have not looked better! Our new landscaper is working hard to stay ahead of the rapidly growing grass now that it's being irrigated on a regular schedule. Our fertilizing and weed control contractor is also working hard to help make the grounds and beds look super. The ditch behind the veterans chapel has been cleaned and it will continue to be on a regular basis. The prayer walk pavers will be removed, new base installed and the pavers reinstalled this fall. You may have noticed there are some preliminary wear spots on the driveway sealer. The contractor has been contacted, they are going to come back and re-seal the areas that have prematurely worn. Our security contractor has been hired to adjust two of the existing units. We have issues with "dumpster divers" at night and folks rifling through the donations left at night at the Thrift Store donation door. Hopefully the adjusted cameras will deter this issue. As I stated at the beginning of my article, I am very excited about the future of our church, presently our main mission, the Thrift Store is "knocking it out of the park" every day, week and month. Alan, Pastor Pat's husband, a US Navy (Go Navy) veteran has presented the council with a great idea. Sponsor a veteran's walkway from the Veterans Chapel to a new "bridge" from the chapel area to the other side of the drainage ditch so we could use that area for family picnics, etc. We would sell bricks (like the prayer walkway) but it would be to the Port Orange community and surrounds. Bringing awareness to the veteran's chapel but also to our church. Art Horton, Chairman


