OPERATION'S REPORT



Even though the church has been closed due to COVID-19, the church office remained open mornings and church maintenance still continued along with some cleaning that still had to be done. We changed pest control companies and immediately found an infestation of termites that were destroyed. We have also changed our grounds maintenance/lawn care company effective May 29th and this should make a marked improvement in the church outside appearance. We are still struggling with having a reliable lawn irrigation system but are close to having it working again on a regular basis. Fortunately we have had timely


rains and the lawn has not suffered too badly. You will also see some work being done around the Veteran's Chapel as we cleanup the entire west side property and remove a lot of the vegetation. The goal is to make this portion of the church property more usable for events such as outside services, church picnics and possible fundraisers. The Operations Team also has been monitoring water and electrical usage during the shutdown and we are happy to report that everything is doing great. On Sunday, May 31, we will be returning to live church services in the Sanctuary, which has been reorganized to reflect "social distancing". Only one entrance will be available. The front door. Upon entering you will find a hand sanitizer station and see that all the chairs have been placed apart. We are fortunate that we have chairs and not pews that cannot be separated. As of this writing, the wearing of masks and hand sanitizing will be required of all individuals for all services and group events inside the church. Financial challenges are still very much a concern as we continue to carefully watch both our income and expenditures. Thank you to everyone who has continued their tithes and giving through the shutdown. Please continue giving as we begin our new "normal". Also, note that financial giving can be done through the church website at www.portorangeucc.org where we have installed a special "Giving" button on the Home page. It is easy to use and you get a full accounting of your gift when you give. Finally, "weeds" on the church property have been growing everywhere and we ask everyone to pull a weed when you see it. If we all do this we will see our weed problem disappear.

The profit we had for the month was due to a very generous Memorial Gift of \$12,000 that we received from the Heffner family in memory of Bill & Betty Heffner. Without that gift we would have had a loss of \$5,071.72 for the month of April and a year-to-date loss of \$10,389.42. We also received \$22,463.45 from the Payroll Protection Plan which is not reflected in the income numbers listed above. We are very fortunate to have received both the Memorial Gift and the PPP income to enable us to carry on with the business of running our very special church. 
