Continued Easter Greetings Brothers and Sisters,

We are an Easter people currently living in the season of Easter. I pray we all live every day as Christians knowing how Jesus was raised from death and ascended into heaven. Jesus followed God's ways to take away our sins and promise us eternal life.

How often do you think about the greatness God has shown us through his son, Jesus Christ? Just on Easter Sunday, maybe a few days during Holy Week, maybe even on Christmas or at the beginning of Advent? How about **every day** you are taking breath on this planet?

Come and be in celebration on Sunday, June 9 as we rejoice together in Holy Communion and rejoice in having three youth confirm their faith in Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior.



As you look at the POUCC Organization chart, try to picture where you might be able to contribute assistance through your time or knowledge. The **Operations Team** especially needs a couple more members. Right now we have three members - Art Horton, Trey Thompson and Bob Brewster, Chair. We need a couple others who understand the importance of overseeing our church finances, buildings, grounds, endowments and benevolent accounts. This is no small task but much easier to handle with a team of five to six versus three members. If you are interested, please contact Bob Brewster. The Operations Team meets the 2nd Monday of the month at 6:30 PM or can also utilize emails for communications and decision making when the need arises. Everyone should know that the Kitchen Air Conditioning Unit is on its last legs. We recently had it serviced and a new thermostat installed and a broken wire on the unit repaired. The present unit is 5-ton in size. A tremendous "overkill" when considering it only does the kitchen area and two bathrooms. A unit one-half its size could do better, be more efficient and cost less to operate. Over the summer we will investigate the cost of replacing this unit. At the same time, we may obtain an estimate for replacing the classroom building roof, which was installed in 2004. A new LED light fixture was installed in the children's classroom bath. This replaces the old fluorescent light fixture that stopped working. Finally, a BIG Thank You! to everyone who pulls weeds, trim bushes or does something outside to keep our church grounds looking neat and trim. May you all have a blessed month of May! ## YOUR FOOD BASKET DONATIONS






